Changes to services

As our church continues to grow and flourish, we have also faced the reality that our clergy and staff are stretched to capacity. After prayerful reflection, the staff team, clergy, churchwardens, and PCC have made the difficult decision to bring the 8am Communion Service to a close, with the final gathering taking place on Sunday, 17th August 2025.

This decision has been made with heavy hearts but also with hope for the long-term sustainability of our ministry. Every member of the 8am congregation was written to a few weeks ago and has since been followed up with a phone call, offering continued support and prayer.

We hope the 8am-ers will take the opportunity over the coming weeks to explore some of our other services, and that they will soon find a new spiritual home within our church community. We aim to have a service of communion every week at one of the services in the parish.

We have also decided that Evensong will now be offered once a term. Steve met with the choir on 27th June to discuss this change, and we're grateful for their understanding and support. The next Evensong will take place on 20th July, and after that, we'll move to a termly schedule. If anyone would like to discuss either of these changes further then please do get in touch with me.
